



NDHSRA Meeting
Topic: National Camping Spots
June 6, 2024, 8:30pm CST
Via Zoom

Meeting was called to order by President Chad Miller at 8:32 pm.

Chad explained that we “generally” need 50 spots for camping at nationals. In Rock Springs we are only allotted 30 electrical hookups, but dry camping spots are also available. Craig was looking into generators for the ND Dry Campers. Craig was going to check with the Fair Board in Williston to see if they will lease Craig the electrical spider boxes they have, if we go that route.

Chad asked what the difference in pricing between electric and dry camping and it is \$395.50 for electric and \$197.75 for dry camping. Chad asked Craig if he knew if there is water close by? He replied there are a couple water spickets in the area. There will be honey wagons available to call for septic dumping. Additional discussion regarding the cost of renting generators and it was believed the cost to be around \$3,000. Kami suggested we reach out to Freedom Oil Field who has been a Killdeer Rodeo sponsor for years and is based out of Rock Springs. That we reach out to them to see if they have generators available for Team ND. Kami will get Craig the contact information.

Chad asked the board how we should decide who gets electrical and dry camping spots. Chad quoted a motion from minutes dated November 17, 2019, that seniors get electric spots, and the rest of the spots were drawn. Craig feels strongly that the queen should receive a spot. Chad would like whatever is decided to be placed into the NDHSRA Policy Manual.

Ryan Madison made a motion to give the queen a spot, then the seniors, after that to ask for any volunteers, and the rest be drawn. Dawn seconded the motion. Chad asked if anyone was opposed? There being no opposition the motion carried.

Ryan R. asked Craig when he would hear back from the fair board about generators. Craig said he hoped to get that all sewed up this week. He was going to send us a group text to let us know what it would cost and that if he was able to rent the Williston Fair Board's generators, he would be responsible for hauling them to Rock Springs.

Craig asked if anyone had names for the National Memorial night. Tammy suggested Rex Cook.

There being no further business to discuss, Ryan M motioned to adjourn the meeting at 8:21 pm. Craig seconded. Motion carried and meeting was adjourned.
