This can be paid in the rodeo office, when you pay your fees (If you use power please pay or they will lock the power boxes next year and we won't be able to use them HONOR System yet for this year. (Check made to McKenzie County AG EXPO) (The camping area is restricted to NO Animals. For this year they are going to allow you to saddle at your trailer (saddle and promptly remove) but please clean up any manure/debris that may be left while saddling ABSOULTY NO feeding your horses in the camping area. (Including Hay Bags) or tying to your trailer for longer than it takes to saddle. Please keep camping area clean so we are allowed to saddle there in the future.
