Camper Hookups: Provided by McKenzie County Ag Expo. This can be paid in the rodeo office, when you pay your fees. (If you use power please pay or they will lock the power boxes next year and we won't be able to use them. The HONOR System will still be used for this year. (Checks can be made payable to McKenzie County AG EXPO.) (The camping area is restricted to NO Animals. For this year they are going to allow you to saddle at your trailer but saddle and promptly remove your horse. Please clean up any manure/debris that may be left while saddling. ABSOLUTELY NO feeding your horses in the camping area. (Including hay bags or tying to your trailer for longer than it takes to saddle.) Please keep the camping area clean so we are allowed to saddle there in the future.

Stalling: There is a stall form attached to the website. Because there are stalls for rent, building your own pens is <u>NOT</u> permitted. You cannot tie to your trailers overnight, you must utilize stalls provided by 4-H Jr Leaders.

Please follow the instructions on the stall form very carefully or you may not have a stall when you arrive. We have a new person in charge of stalls this year that is supervising the McKenzie County Jr Leaders. Be sure to get your stall forms sent on time so you get the number of stalls you need. Be sure to clean your stalls before you leave. McKenzie County Jr Leaders did assess some fines last year and will do so again. (\$50 per stall) (Be respectful of our new facility & grounds and clean your stalls and around your trailer before you leave.) (DO NOT shovel out your trailers at the grounds.)
